OUR BCH HEADOUARTERS IS EXPANDING I

Our Largo campus is home to both BCH and Conserv HQ. Many of you know that the bulk of the administrative and design work is completed here, but what might surpise you is that it's also the site of our in-house CAD/VDC offices and sheet metal shop. We're excited to announce that we're making headway in our recent expansion effort. We've added a new 2-story building that will allow us to accommodate our advancements in prefabrication, as well as our growing administrative staff. The additional 28,000 sq. ft. will house our new and improved sheet metal shop, featuring many upgrades; an office suite; and a new piping facility.

PROJECT SPOTLIGHT

WHAT IS HAPPENING AT MOFFITT?

Moffitt Cancer Center has a master plan to upgrade and expand their current campus, and BCH is proud to be an integral part of it. We are currently performing multiple projects there:

- We're working with Wehr Constructors on pharmacy upgrades, including IDS Pharmacy, MCB Pharmacy, MIP Pharmacy, and MKC Pharmacy.
- We're partnering with Whiting-Turner on the M2GEN project.
- We're performing the bed expansion with Barr & Barr.

The \$800M expansion includes a patient bed tower, on 22 acres across from the main center on McKinley Dr. The 1st phase will feature 128 in-patient beds (in addition to the 200 beds the facility currently has), 24 surgical suites, radiology, endoscopy, imaging, as well as conference, education & research space.



The 2nd phase will include 76 in-patient beds, radiotherapy and infusion therapy.

ConServ Building Services provides a website for customer use, so they may monitor the detailed status of each service work order they have assigned to us. However, a large portion of our customers use their own individual websites to track the status of their service work orders.

Each "Customer Provided" website requires manual updates to individual work orders by our Service Admin staff any time the status of a work order changes. It can be a monumental task and can be less than a great customer experience during peak periods.

Using an API (Application Programming Interface), information from our service dispatch software can be transmitted directly to a customer's website or dispatch software. Each customer is unique regarding what data they want to have transmitted regarding status. Customers who work with us to utilize this technology enjoy Real Time Status updates automatically.

We are very excited to announce that on September 23rd, Target began receiving automatic updates regarding work order ETA's, arrival and completion times and technician notes along with other miscellaneous work order specifics they require to operate their business.

Target Corp and ConServ Building Services have a longstanding history of working closely together to develop efficiencies in service operations. We are confident that this is a huge step in operational efficiency for us both and we are very excited that we have reached yet another milestone in our relationship.
